THE EXHIBITION

- **WANDER & WONDER: Picture Your Metro Parks** is an exhibition of photographs taken within the past three years in any of the 19 Columbus and Franklin County Metro Parks. (See metroparks.net for all parks information).
- Photo subjects are of wildlife, beautiful park scenery and people enjoying activities at the parks.
- A total of 60 photographs will be selected for exhibition at Grange Insurance Audubon Center.
- All entries will be displayed on both the Metro Parks and Audubon Center websites.
- Opening reception, with refreshments, will be held Sunday March 1, 2020 from 2 to 4pm.

SUBMITTING PHOTOS

- Submit up to two digital photographs for jurying at Metro Parks' secure Google site: tiny.cc/ww-photo-exhibit
- An automatic email acknowledgement will confirm your submissions. (Please submit your photos on two separate forms)
- The deadline for submitting photos is Sunday January 26, 2020.

INFORMATION REQUIRED (to be used for gallery labels)

- Your first and last name, email address, title of your photo/s, name of the Metro Park/s in which they were taken, and a sale price for each. Photos can be uploaded from Thursday August 1, 2019 to Sunday January 6, 2020



JURYING

- All digital entries will be reviewed by a panel of three judges.
- Photographers will be notified of their successful acceptance into the main exhibition on Monday February 3, 2020.
- Confirm by Monday February 10 that you intend to submit your work/s for the exhibition.
- The photographs must be printed on Luster photo paper. (Audubon Center uses a terrific magnetic display system to hang the photographs, so matting and framing aren't needed).
- Minimum photo size 11" x 14" / maximum photo size 14" x 18".
- Prizes will be awarded to the photographs placed first, second and third by the judges.

TAKE-IN

- Take-in at Grange Insurance Audubon Center is between 10am and 5pm, Wednesday February 26 to Friday February 28, 2020.

TAKE-DOWN

- Take-down is on Monday April 6, 2020. Photographers may collect any unsold works from the Audubon Center during work hours between Monday and Friday. Photographs will be available for collection for up to two months after take-down. Please collect your photographs within that time frame, as they will then be disposed of.

DIGITAL WEBSITE EXHIBITION

- The digital galleries of all the photographs submitted for jurying will go live at metroparks.net and at grange.audubon.org from Tuesday March 17, 2020.
