Mr. Moloney gave a brief update on Covid-19 and the implications to Metro Parks.

Operations

Beginning on March 13, we entered into Incident Command Management (ICM) in regard to the COVID-19 outbreak. On nice weather days, parks have been extremely busy. Rangers are enforcing 10 person maximum gathering guidelines and social distancing—no problems with either as visitors are very good at following rules/suggestions. We do see issues with dogs on nature trails and similar rule violations but are focusing on bigger issues. All parks are open from 6:30 am to 8:00 pm daily. Limited staff is on duty with rotating squads and ICM structure in place. Significant efforts made to sanitize restrooms on an on-going basis. Animal care, Inniswood, and Farm Animal Care strike teams in place. All programs and facility reservations cancelled through June 1. Nature centers were closed. Parks have been busy on good weather day—limited use of shelters with most people on trails walking and maintaining social distancing.
