

RESOLUTION NO. 5848

AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT FOR STORMWATER IMPROVEMENTS AT QUARRY TRAILS METRO PARK

WHEREAS, Metro Parks is in the process of converting Quarry Trails Metro Park for public use with a variety of experiences and opportunities over the next several years; and

WHEREAS, this year's planned project that includes the relocation of Millikin Ditch, developing a pond system outlet channel to the Scioto River, constructing pedestrian bridge abutments, creating a kayak channel and installing a stormwater drainage culvert; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of this work has been estimated to be \$1,900,000 for which funds have been included in the 2020 Metro Parks Capital Improvement Budget; and


WHEREAS, the project was bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 307.86 to 307.92 inclusive with seven bids received; and

WHEREAS, Facemyer Company submitted the lowest and best bid in the amount of \$1,704,033.95, Now, Therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Park Commissioners of the Columbus and Franklin County Metropolitan Park District hereby authorizes the Director to enter into contract with Facemyer Company for \$1,704,033.95 for stormwater improvements at Quarry Trails Metro Park and any additional services deemed necessary for completion of the project.
