AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT TO SELL GROUNDWATER MITIGATION CREDITS AT PRAIRIE OAKS METRO PARK

WHEREAS, Columbus and Franklin County Metro Parks ("Metro Parks") promotes the conservation, preservation and restoration of native plant and animal communities through numerous resource management projects; and

WHEREAS, Metro Parks has entered into an agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA") to establish a groundwater mitigation bank at Prairie Oaks Metro Park that promotes surface and groundwater protection in the Big Darby Creek Watershed while generating funds for additional land protection in the Darby Watershed; and

WHEREAS, on September 9, 2014, the Board of Park Commissioners of the Columbus and Franklin County Metro Parks approved an agreement with Ohio EPA that establishes the mitigation bank and to sell groundwater mitigation credits as needed in the Big Darby Creek Watershed; and

WHEREAS, KL Petroleum has requested the purchase of 4.9 acres from the groundwater mitigation bank at a cost of \$78,400; Now, Therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Park Commissioners of the Columbus and Franklin County Metropolitan Park District hereby authorizes the Executive Director to enter into an agreement with KL Petroleum to sell 4.9 acres at a cost of \$78,400.

AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A PRE-CAST RESTROOM FOR THE SHADY GROVE PICNIC AREA OF SLATE RUN METRO PARK

WHEREAS, Slate Run Metro Park is a popular destination for Franklin County and Central Ohio residents and includes the Shady Grove Picnic Area, which features picnic shelters, trail access, playgrounds and other amenities for park visitors to enjoy; and

WHEREAS, currently the Shady Grove Area is serviced by two out of date vault latrines; and

WHEREAS, bids were formally advertised to purchase a pre-cast restroom to replace these vault latrines at an estimated cost of \$ 75,000; and

WHEREAS, one bid was submitted in the amount of \$72,625 by Norwalk Concrete Industries, a company Columbus and Franklin County Metro Parks has had successful projects with in the past; and

WHEREAS, funds are available in the 2021 Metro Parks Capital Improvement Budget to purchase the pre-cast and install the pre-cast restroom and to prepare the site for installation; and

WHEREAS, this project is also supported by a generous \$25,000 donation by a regular park visitor; Now, Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by this Board of Park Commissioners of the Columbus and Franklin Metropolitan Park District that the Executive Director may enter into a contract with Norwalk Concrete Industries in the amount of \$72,625 and further authorizes expenditure of funds for site preparations and any necessary change orders needed to successfully complete this project.
