BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Park Commissioners of the Columbus and Franklin County Metropolitan Park District hereby authorizes the Director to enter into a design/build contract with Burgess & Niple, Inc. at an estimated cost of \$1,000,000 for the construction of wetland restoration at Walnut Woods Metro Park and any additional services deemed necessary for completion of the project.
