

METRO PARKS SCIOTO FEST 2022 CAMPING INFO



BASICS

- Camping during Scioto Fest is FREE!
- Check in at the information tent once you arrive.
- Metro Parks staff will be onsite at all times, even overnight.
- Bring your own gear - tents, sleeping bags, sleeping pads, chairs, food, water, etc.
- Individual fires aren't permitted, but you may bring individual camp stoves and food to prepare.
- Dogs are welcome and need to be on a leash at all times in the camping area.
- Porta-johns will be available.
- Overall rule of thumb: be a decent human. Pick up after yourself, honor quiet hours, follow park rules, etc. and we'll all have a pretty groovy time.
