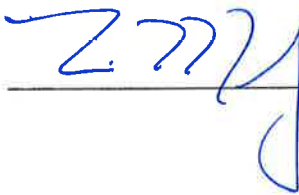

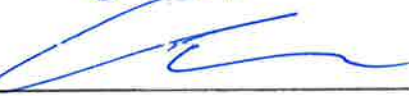

ADOPTING THE COLUMBUS AND FRANKLIN COUNTY METRO PARKS
CYBERSECURITY PROGRAM

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 9.64, enacted through House Bill 96, the Columbus and Franklin County Metro Parks ("Metro Parks") is required to adopt a cybersecurity program that safeguards its data, IT systems, and resources to ensure confidentiality, availability and integrity; and

WHEREAS, failure to comply may lead to audit findings, financial liabilities, operational disruption, and reputational harm; and

WHEREAS, the law mandates use of generally accepted cybersecurity best practices, including frameworks such as the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Cybersecurity Framework and the Center for Internet Security (CIS) best practices; and

WHEREAS, Metro Parks relies on computer systems, networks, software and digital data to provide further the mission and provide services to citizens; and

WHEREAS, cyber incidents, including data breaches, ransomware attacks, unauthorized access, system disruptions, and other malicious cyber events, pose risks to the Metro Parks' operations, financial integrity and the security of sensitive information; and

WHEREAS, Metro Parks recognizes the need for a clear process by which any cyber incident is promptly evaluated and appropriate actions are taken to protect Metro Parks operations, employees, citizens and public resources; and

WHEREAS, Metro Parks finds it in the best interest of Metro Parks to establish a formal review procedure so that each cyber incident is addressed on a case-by-case basis, ensuring flexibility and effective response; Now, Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Park Commissioners of the Columbus and Franklin County Metropolitan Park District hereby adopts the Columbus and Franklin County Metro Parks Cybersecurity Program and directs the IT Division to implement the program consistent with House Bill 96 and best practices.

AUTHORIZING ASSIGNMENT OF A CONSERVATION EASEMENT TO RAPID 5 FOR
THE CUMBERLAND TRAIL GOLF COURSE IN LICKING COUNTY, OHIO

WHEREAS, Whereas the Columbus and Franklin County Metropolitan Parks District, Board of Park Commissioners approved Resolution 6184 on August 20, 2024 to accepted a Conservation Easement from Cumberland Estates LLC on the Cumberland Trail Golf Course in Licking County; and

WHEREAS, staff has been determined that another conservation-based agency is best suited to manage and hold the easement in Licking County with Rapid 5 being recommended; and

WHEREAS, Metro Parks and Rapid 5 have established a partnership over the years with similar initiatives in the conservation and preservation of open spaces in Central Ohio; and

WHEREAS, Rapid 5 has agree to accept the Conservation Easement on the Cumberland Trail Golf Course located in the City of Pataskala, Licking County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, this Board deems the assignment of this conservation easement to be in the public interest; Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Park Commissioners of the Columbus and Franklin County Metropolitan Park District hereby exercises its right to assign a conservation easement to Rapid 5 and herewith directs and authorizes its Executive Director, as agent for this Board, to execute the necessary documents.
